

## SPRING CLEAN-UP – May 8<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> – On Your Regular Collection Day

- ✓ CLEAR BAG RULES APPLY (One Black Bag Only) – MAXIMUM OF 20 ITEMS PER HOUSEHOLD
- ✓ One Item = 1 Object, 1 Clear Bag, 1 Bundle or 1 Container (No Cardboard Boxes)
- ✓ Five Loose Objects = 5 Items – Bundles Must be Tied & Not Exceed 4 Ft. in Length
- ✓ Microwaves are Accepted in this Clean-Up
- X **NO Metal Items – Appliances, Bicycles, Car Parts, Barbecues, Etc. NO Items Over 75 Lbs.**
- X **NO Mattresses, Box Springs, Sofas, Furniture, Tires, Electronics, Paint or Household Hazardous Waste**

- Location – Pictou County Solid Waste Management Facility, Mt. William Site
- Two FREE Bags of Compost per Household – While Supply Lasts – Bring Your Shovel!
- Please Reuse Your Bags from Last Year When Possible; We Will Supply Our Bags as Needed
- Looking to Buy More? \$2 (Your Bag) - \$2.60 (Our Bag) - \$30 plus HST (Tonne)

## TOWN LEAF COLLECTION – May 29<sup>th</sup>-June 9<sup>th</sup> – On Your Regular Collection Day

- ✓ Leaves Must be in Clear, Orange or Paper Bags – Unlimited Number of Bags of Leaves Accepted
- ✓ Leaves Should be Set Out, Separated from Garbage Bags
- ✓ Leaves Can be Put in the Green Cart on a Regular Basis – Leaves Can be Put in a Backyard Composter
- X **NO Leaves Permitted in Black Bags**
- X **NO LEAF COLLECTION FOR RESIDENTS IN THE COUNTY AREAS**
